GMOD is a collection of open source software components for managing, visualizing and annotating biological data. It is also an active community of biologists and developers addressing common challenges with a shared tool set.

Community Meeting

Two full days of presentations & discussion on GMOD components, best practices, and project direction, featuring GMOD users and developers. New, potential, and veteran users are encouraged to attend. A special project overview session will be held the night before to introduce new and potential users to the GMOD project.

Satellite Meetings

One day of informal special interest group / birds-of-a-feather meetings where GMOD Community members discuss and work on topics of common interest.

Spring Training

A five-day hands on course on GMOD component installation, configuration and usage. The course will cover many popular components, including annotation tools (*MAKER, Apollo*), visualization tools (*GBrowse, JBrowse, GBrowse_syn*), database systems (*Chado, InterMine, Tripal*), analysis & data integration (*Galaxy, GFF3*).
